This is an Alcohol & Drug Free Party for Seniors after Graduation **Thursday May 26**. The event begins at 10:30 p.m at the SHS Gym. Seniors will be transported to Ft Chaffee to enjoy music, food, games, sporting events & lots of fun activities, and then return to Southside around 3:00 a.m. on May 27 where breakfast will be served and prizes distributed. Students will then be dismissed --**NO early dismissals!**

TICKET SALES:

Tickets: will be the T-Shirt you receive as you check-in on the night of Mash Bash

Sign-up: Wednesday, April 27th - Friday, May 6th during lunch, by cafeteria. **NO TICKETS SOLD AFTER MAY 6!!**

1. DRUG & ALCOHOL FREE NIGHT: The use or possession of alcohol or drugs WILL NOT BE TOLERATED!! Smoking is prohibited. Anyone caught possessing or showing effects of chemicals will be required to leave the party with their parents/guardians.
2. DRESS CODE: Mash Bash T-shirts (handed out upon arrival at SHS), tennis shoes (no black soles on gym floors), shorts or pants. Mash Bash T-Shirts must be worn by all persons at all times during the party, including adult workers.
3. NO MONEY NEEDED: Leave money at home as your ticket covers everything. All equipment for sports & games will be provided. NO bags or backpacks allowed. Purses are allowed, but must be checked at the "Check Rooms" on arrival at Ft. Chaffee.
4. ARRIVAL AT SHS GYM: Seniors should arrive at main gym at 10:30 PM, where you will receive your Mash Bash t-shirt and bus assignment. Buses will depart for Ft. Chaffee at 11:00PM. If students purchased their tickets at the same time, we will try to assign them the same bus, but there is no guarantee. You must ride your assigned bus to and from Ft. Chaffee. Students in cars will not be admitted to Ft. Chaffee.
5. PHONING PARENTS: Students are NOT allowed to call their parents to pick them up at Ft. Chaffee at any time unless it is an emergency and has been cleared through Security or Mash Bash Chairman.
6. BEHAVIOR PROBLEMS: A student required to leave the party will be held in a detention area until a parent/guardian arrives to pick them up. The parent/guardian and Chairman must sign a release form. A student attempting to leave the designated areas of use at Ft. Chaffee will have their parents called and will be required to leave. Students leaving for any reason will not be allowed to return.
7. "NO SHOW" STUDENTS: Parents/Guardians will be notified of "No Show" students.
8. FIRST AID: Available for minor illnesses or injuries. An ambulance will transport anyone with more serious conditions to a Ft. Smith hospital.
9. SECURITY FOR CARS LEFT AT SHS: A policeman will patrol the school parking lot that night.
10. LIABILITY RELEASE FORM: Form below must be signed by both student and parent / guardian. It must be turned in at the time your ticket is purchased.
